- Official transcript
- Personal statement The committee reviews this component very carefully in order to help match recipients with donor's intent.
- Two current letters of recommendation (one academic and one character)
- All military applicants must provide their DD214.
- All art scholarship applicants must submit a portfolio with 3-5 pieces of original art along with your supporting documents.
- All supporting documents must be submitted, in ONE packet by noon on Friday, March 21, 2025 at the Student Success Center at CT State Quinebaug Valley in Danielson
- Willimantic students may submit packets at the Connecticut State Quinebaug Valley Willimantic campus on Wednesdays from 10:30 am to 4:00 pm through March 21, 2025.
